She notes that much of the work in the show suggests that identity is inherently unstable or subject to change and revision. Changeability and instability are in turn linked to a questioning of the very concept of identity. Kent continues in some works a central core of identity is challenged or negated altogether and substituted instead by endless simulacra rather like a hall of mirrors that reflect repeatedly back at one another by Susan Best.
